Can, could, and able to

We can use can to say that something is possible or allowed, or that somebody has the ability to do something.

Lo usamos para decir que algo es probable o permitido o que alguien tiene la capacidad de hacer algo.

Robert's team member dropped out of class. They were doing a project together, but Robert managed to hand in the project on his own.

Philip could speak Italian and he could sing in a choir.

Zach can't attend the spiritual retreat on Friday.

We could use could for general ability. But if you want to say that somebody did something in a specific situation, use was/were able to or managed to (not could).
